

## 11/03/17 ELAC Meeting Minutes

Welcome & Intro – All members presented introduced themselves.  
As members entered, they completed the Needs Assessment.

Reviews of Agenda – No changes were made to the agenda as posted.

Guest Speaker/Presentation – Mrs. Martin presented the results of the school's 16-17 state test results. Parents requested to look at the Gender subgroup and compared performances between grade levels.
